

## PATRIZIA TASSINI



The internationally renowned soloist Patrizia Tassini has won the worldwide public's appreciation. She studied the harp with E. Vio at the "G.Tartini" Conservatory in Trieste, graduating "cum laude". She studied in France and the USA at the Eastman School of Music, University of Rochester (N.Y.), absolving the Master's Degree in Performance and Literature as well as the Performance Certificate.

Tassini won the First prize at the II International Harp Competition in Varallo; the Second prize at the International Harp Contest in Israel (1982) and the USA Concerto Competition (1984). She has recorded for the Italian National Radio Network (RAI) and Radio France. The harpist collaborates with the flutists Maxence Larrieu, Giorgio Marcossi, and Massimo Mercelli, and appears with the Mainz Kammerorchester, the Zagreb Soloists, and the Serbian Radio Television Orchestra, among others.

Patrizia Tassini is regularly invited to be a juror at national and international competitions: the International Harp Contest in Israel, the USA International Harp Competition, Martin Geliot Harp Competition, Prix at the CNSMDP (France), Godefroid Harp Competition (Belgium), International Harp Competition in Belgrade (Serbia), International Harp Competition of Slovenian Harp Association. She has served on the Board of Directors of the World Harp Congress.

Patrizia Tassini conducts the Harp Orchestra Ventaglio d'Arpe and was the harp professor of Harp at the "J. Tomadini" Conservatory in Udine. Recently she held concerts and masterclasses around Europe, in China, Taiwan, and Turkey.
