LUISA PRANDINA



Luisa Prandina studied at the Civica Scuola di Musica in Milan, graduating at the age of 15 with honors. At the age of ten she won the first prize in the national competition "Bellini" in Como and subsequently several national and international competitions.

Since 1986 she has been principal harp of the European Community Youth Orchestras (ECYO), Frankfurt Radio, the Chamber Orchestra of Europe. At the age of 23 she became the first harp of the Teatro alla Scala orchestra, having won the international competition to fill this role.

Luisa Prandina carry out an intense concert activity both in chamber ensembles, with prestigious musicians such as Yuri Bashmet, Dora Schwarzberg, and, as a soloist, with famous orchestras such as the Filarmonica della Scala, Solisti Veneti, Virtuosi di Mosca, Mahler Chamber Orchestra. She is a guest soloist in important halls, such as the Teatro alla Scala in Milan, the Sala Verdi of the Milan Conservatory, the Philharmonie in Berlin, the Kurhaus in Wiesbaden. She is a visiting professor at Conservatorio Superiore di Namur, Fiesole Scuola di Musica and Civica Scuola di Musica C. Abbado, and coach for the Mahler orchestra and the EUYO.
